Commander Regal Deluxe**

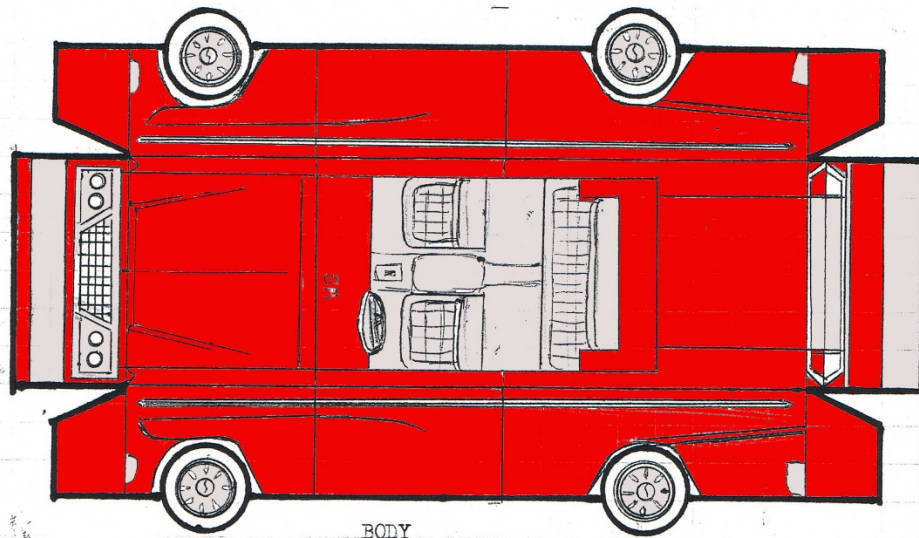
Cost: \$1,871.

Like other car companies, Studebaker halted production with the war in '42. After the war, they hired Loewy Associates and got their new postwar designs out ahead of the other car companies in '46 and '47. This proved to be a successful strategy. In 1950 the Loewy Studios produced the famous "bullet-nose." The innovative streamlined design made Studebaker one of the most advanced cars on the road, and the company had its best year in 1950. The demise of the company fourteen years later, was probably due more to the price-cutting wars by Ford and Chevy, which smaller companies such as Studebaker could not match, than to the product itself.

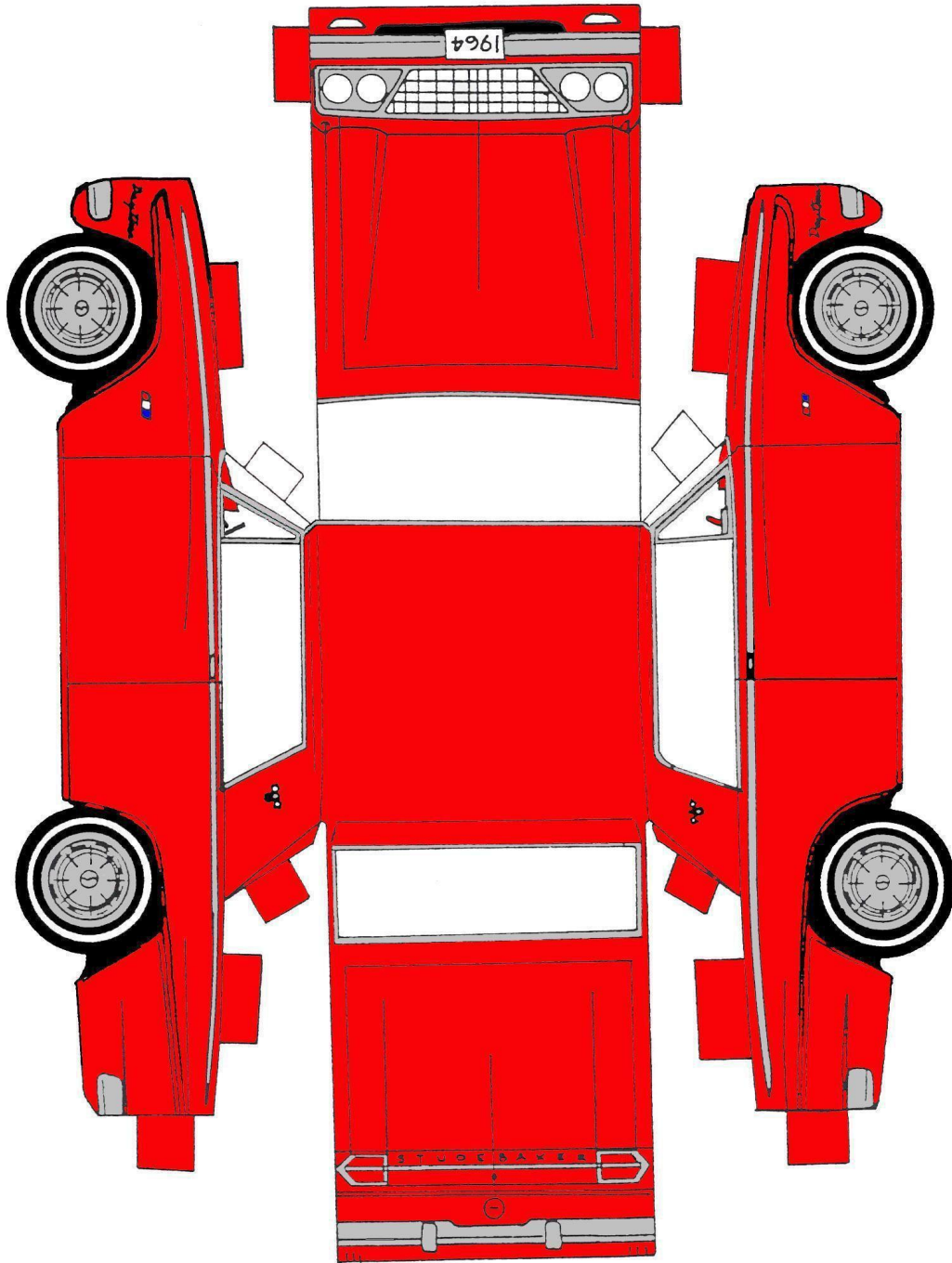
WINDSHIELD

1964 Studebaker Convertible

1. Cut out parts along thick black lines.
2. Fold the body together, forming a box, along thin, black lines.
3. Fold windshield along thin, black lines.
4. Glue body together. Let dry.
5. Glue windshield to body, where marked 'WS'
6. Display your completed Studebaker.
